

How to Upload Documents in Pakistan Online Visa System

- When applying through the Pakistan Online Visa System, you will be required to upload supporting documents (e.g. **passport, photograph & all mandatory supporting documents based on your visa type**).
- This guide explains the steps for uploading supporting documents to all type of Visa Applications. You can upload your photograph and supporting documents by following the procedure below;

Allowed document Type / Size

- ✓ **Allowed file types: JPEG, JPG, PNG, PDF**
- ✓ **Allowed file size: 7 MB**

Attaching Documents to an Application

- Login to your Pakistan Online Visa System account.

- In the Document Uploading section, follow the steps below:-





Step 3: Find and select the file to be uploaded as shown below.








